My interest in academic research sparked off with my undergraduate dissertation work titled "An Appraisal of the Functions of Local Planning Authorities in Osun State: A Comparative Analysis of Six Selected Local Government Areas of Osun State". At graduate level, I began to channel my research focus towards Transport Planning, hence, my M. Sc Thesis topic was "A Study of Travel Patterns of Civil Servants in Osogbo, Osun

State". My five (5) years sojourn in the College of Health Sciences, where I worked with a Project that upgraded Masters in Community Health to Masters of Public Health (MPH) from Johns Hopkins School of Public Health, Bloomberg Maryland, USA, gave birth to two things. First, my performance at the interview that led to my appointment as Teaching Assistant compelled the Director of the Project to engage me in the data analysis of two sets of data, collected two years prior to my appointment. Two papers were published from them (iii and iv). Second, my research interest in transport and Health Planning today, was conceived from my interactions with the medically inclined colleagues. At the doctoral level, my research focus was zeroed in on Transport and Health Planning. This is a reason my doctoral thesis was titled "Study of Commuting Stress of Passengers and Drivers of Commercial Minibuses in Lagos State, Nigeria". The subsequent publications focus on different domains of health and Urban and Regional Planning. Fourteen (14) publications are presented. Two (2) contributions to books in the domain of transport planning (Papers i & ii). There are seven (7) journal publications: Two (2) of which focus on health planning (Papers iii & iv). Also, two (2) focused on infrastructure planning (Papers v & vi), four (4) focused on transport and health related filed (Papers vii, viii, ix & xi) and one (1) journal publication focused on environmental health (Paper x). There are two referred conference papers, out of which one (1) is on environmental health (xii) and one (1) on transport planning (xiii). The 14th journal publication has been accepted and its focus is transport planning. I have been supervising students' research in my area of specialisation, transport and health planning, and in other domains of urban planning at both the undergraduate and graduate levels. These efforts also yielded a publication that I coauthored with the students as a way of mentoring them (Papers xi). Furthermore, I have been in collaborations with colleagues which have led to the publications. Generally, these publications have proffered policy responses that address a lot of urban transport issues. I have taught several undergraduate students in several courses in the course of my academic career in the last 15 years of my sojourn in the Department.
