My interest in academic research sparked off with my undergraduate dissertation work titled “An Appraisal of the Functions of Local Planning Authorities in Osun State: A Comparative Analysis of Six Selected Local Government Areas of Osun State”.

At graduate level, I began to channel my research focus towards Transport Planning, hence, my M. Sc Thesis was titled “Travel Patterns of Health-Seeking Civil Servants in Osogbo, Osun State, Nigeria”.

My Ph.D thesis is still on Transport Planning, with the title “Study of Commuting Stress of Passengers and Drivers of Commercial Minibuses in Lagos State, Nigeria”.

I am presenting 18 publications in all. I have been supervising students’ research in Planning generally and in my area of specialisation, that is, Transport Planning, at both the undergraduate and graduate levels. These efforts also yielded 2 publications that I co-authored with the students as a way of mentoring them (Papers xi & vxiii). Furthermore, I have been collaborating with my colleagues which have led to the publications of some papers. Generally, these publications have proffered policy responses that address a lot of urban transport issues. In all, I am presenting eight (08) publications on Transport Planning (Papers i, ii, vii, viii, ix, xi, xii, & xvii). Two on

infrastructure planning (Papers v & vi), while, three are referred conference papers (Papers xv, xvi & xvii). In addition to my publications, I have supervised and taught undergraduate and postgraduate students in several courses in the course of my academic career in the last 16 years sojourn.
